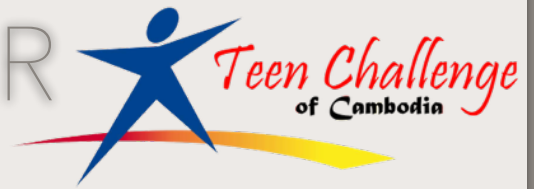

A young woman knows she needs help. She sees the way her addictions are destroying her life and her family, and she wants something new. She wants to try Teen Challenge's recovery and rehabilitation program. But what about her kids?

They are welcome too. Teen Challenge Cambodia takes a holistic approach to recovery from addiction, and we believe that mothers and children are better together. We allow mothers to bring their children with them into the program, and our staff care for the children just as they care for the clients.

While the clients participate in the recovery program, Teen Challenge staff provide a safe and nurturing place for the clients' children to grow and develop. The children receive proper physical care and nutrition as they too heal from past

trauma they may have faced. The children can study in our pre-school or in the local public school, and all their daily needs are met.

Teen Challenge's commitment to care for these children springs from a deep compassion for victims of addiction—both the ones trapped in addiction and those directly affected by his or her actions. If Teen Challenge refused these children, they would be extremely vulnerable to abuse and mistreatment. Some would go to stay with relatives, but there would be no guarantee that the child would receive proper care and education. In fact, mothers would likely refuse to enter the residential program out of concern for their children's wellbeing.

A mother and child are better together, and together, we can make that happen.

For \$80 a month, or \$960 per year, we can keep a mother and child together. For \$80 per month, in our residential center we can meet all the basic needs of a child—nutritious food, medical care, education, everything!
