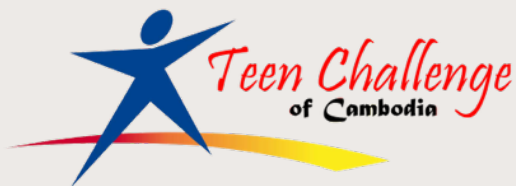


# GIVING HOPE

In Phnom Penh, a young woman sells her body to buy her next fix. She cares for her children by day and works the streets of the city by night. Meanwhile, a young man pawns his cell phone and steals from his parents. He huddles with his friends taking a hit of crystal meth. He loves it. He hates it. He doesn't know where to go.

Teen Challenge Cambodia offers hope for those who are trapped in addiction. There is a place to go. There are people who care. There is another option.

Through Teen Challenge's one year residential program, men and women suffering from addictions to drugs and alcohol can find new life and new hope in Jesus Christ. Our staff go to meet those in need where they are and invite them to a safe place where they can recover from

their addictions and even learn a new skill for their future.

Addiction affects the entirety of one's life, and so Teen Challenge responds with a holistic approach as well.

In a nurturing environment, clients receive physical care and medical treatment, character formation classes and spiritual encouragement, and counseling and psychological care. As clients recover from their addictions, they also have opportunities to participate in literacy classes and vocational skill training to equip them for a sustainable future.

One year can make a difference—from sickness to health, from despair to joy. Together we can give hope to men and women trapped in addiction.

For \$3,000, we can offer a scholarship for one client for one year. This covers the entirety of the client's treatment—food, medical care, counseling, everything!
